

## Medi-Cal Changes Coming!

Starting January 1, 2026, adults 19 and older who are not pregnant and not eligible for full-scope Medi-Cal due to immigration status can get restricted Medi-Cal, which only covers emergency and pregnancy-related care.

Now, more than ever, it's important to keep your Medi-Cal coverage up to date.

### How to Renew

- **Online:** Log in to [www.BenefitsCal.com](http://www.BenefitsCal.com).
- **By Phone:** Call the phone number provided in your renewal notice or your yellow envelope from the county, or by visiting [www.Medi-Cal.dhcs.ca.gov](http://www.Medi-Cal.dhcs.ca.gov) and select "Find my local Medi-Cal office".
- **By Mail or In Person:** Find a county office by visiting [www.dhcs.ca.gov](http://www.dhcs.ca.gov) and enter your zip code to find an office close to you.

### Reminders (alarm clock icon)

- Submit your renewal by the deadline date, it is very important to keep your Medi-Cal coverage.
- Review the information on the form carefully to make sure your information is correct. It is important to correct any errors and add any missing information.
